Course Book None All course material provided	Prior Knowledge Required Students attending this informal course are expected to be able to interact in a simple way with a person who talks slowly and is prepared to help, and to ask and answer basic questions about personal details. They should be able to read and understand simple sentences using everyday words and phrases, and to write straightforward statements about themselves (e.g., personal information, likes & dislikes) and their immediate environment (e.g., location, weather).

Course Aims

This 8-hour programme is designed to give an opportunity to students who have completed any of our pre-A1 courses (Complete Beginner, Beginner Plus or Early Elementary), or are within that range of levels, to practice their oral production and comprehension skills through a mix of basic conversation, role play and listening activities in an informal atmosphere.
